

If the parish exceeds its goal, a rebate will be paid equal to 100% of the amount by which the parish exceeds its goal. Rebates paid are exempt from the 10% eparchial assessment. *June 30th is the deadline to pledge.*

<u>RELIEF FUND:</u> The Eparchy of Parma established this Emergency Relief Fund to provide for our retired priests' pension and health insurance plan and to assist families of priests in need. Parishes were not able to cover these costs during the coronavirus crisis. Our foreign priests have no way of increasing their household income and do not qualify for government assistance, and their families are living below the poverty level. - no camping of any kind is permitted food will not be available for purchase at the cafeteria so you are welcome to bring your own food masks are encouraged but will not be furnished bring your own chair to maintain social distancing (folding chairs will not be available) bottled water will be provided

Please note: Picnic tables will NOT be available for use.

- For the courage to sing in church Holy Father Roman, pray for us! (40 times)
- For the departed Psalm 51, 91, 119 (50, 90, 118 in LXX)
- Jesus Prayer "Lord Jesus Christ,* Son of God,* have mercy on me* a sinner!"

Every evening before you go to bed, simply go through the whole day and think what you have done right or wrong, do the examination of conscience, and ask the good Lord for forgiveness. Make a sign of the cross over the place where you sleep and say: "Into your hands, O Lord, I commend my soul and body. Do You Yourself bless me, have mercy on me, and grant me life eternal. Amen."
